

T&T ATHLETE OF THE YEAR

1. Senior Elite athletes will be considered for the Athlete of the Year.
2. Points will be added together starting at USA Gymnastics Championships up to but not including the following USA Gymnastics Championships.
3. In the case of a tie, the points earned at the event with the highest point allocation for that year based on the points allocation chart, will be used to break the tie. If still tied, both/all athletes will be awarded.
4. Trampoline Athlete of the Year will include individual results only.
5. Athlete of the Year will be given for 3 disciplines (Trampoline, Double-Mini and Tumbling).

T&T COACH OF THE YEAR

1. Coaches of Senior Elite athletes will be considered for the Coach of the Year, using the points gained by athletes for AOTY.
2. In the case of a tie, the points earned at the event with the highest point allocation for that year based on the points allocation chart, will be used to break the tie. If still tied, both/all coaches will be awarded.
3. A coach of an athlete in the current year will gain 75% of that athlete's points. A coach of an athlete in the previous year will gain 25% of that athlete's points.
4. Both discipline-specific and Overall Coach of the Year (combined points across TRA, TUM and DMT) will be announced.
