1. Olympic Games Team – Women

The committee reviewed the selection procedures and cross-checked the results.

The committee discussed the open grievance within Women’s Trampoline and agreed that only the Olympian and replacement athlete would be named at this time, with a second replacement athlete to be considered once the grievance process was concluded.

3. Olympic Games Team – Coaches

5. Olympic Games Team – Women’s Replacement Athletes

The outcome of the grievance has been received. The arbitrator’s decision was to overturn the USAG Ethics & Grievance Committee decision and reinstate the original scores published on the USAG website following the VIP Classic.

The committee expressed their empathy towards all affected athletes, and acknowledged the disruption and uncertainty that all have experienced.

The committee members clarified and agreed that it is the job of the committee to look at the set of numbers resulting from the outcome and apply the selection procedures accordingly. The members have no input into or bearing on the outcome of the hearing itself.

It was confirmed that the June 28 deadline contained in the selection procedures was formally extended by the USOPC in recognition of the open grievance, to July 3.

Motion to select Sarah Webster as the 2020 Olympic Games first replacement athlete.

It was clarified that Charlotte Drury would thus become the 2020 Olympic Games second replacement athlete.

The committee supports the stance taken by USAG to travel both replacement athletes to Tokyo in light of this circumstance, and all efforts to support both replacement athletes equally in their roles.

The committee discussed the roster of coaches already selected, and it was agreed that the coaches chosen should remain with no changes required.
