



WOMEN'S INTERNATIONAL ELITE COMMITTEE MEETING
April 20, 2020

All decisions regarding 2020 activities and competitions are dependent on when stay-at-home orders are lifted nation-wide. The IEC recommends a minimum of twelve weeks of training for athletes and coaches to prepare to compete in 2020.

- A. 2020 US Championships – The IEC discussed the possibility of US Championships occurring in the fall. USA Gymnastics is exploring all options surrounding this. The IEC recommends to USA Gymnastics to cancel 2020 Championships. The committee believes, after the mandatory time off due to COVID-19, there will not be time for the athletes to recover and prepare properly for the 2021 season.
 - 1. The IEC recommends that athletes currently named to the National Team remain on the National Team if 2020 US Championships does not occur.
 - 2. The IEC recommends that at the 2021 February National Team Camp, athletes will be re-ranked and named to the 2021 National Team.
- B. 2020 Hopes Championships – The IEC discussed hosting Hopes Championships in the fall at the Training Center. Athletes currently qualified to Hopes Classic would be invited to compete at Hopes Championships. The IEC discussed hosting a Classic competition in conjunction with the Hopes Championships for those athletes who may want to participate.
- C. Elite Compulsory Changes – Changes to the Elite Compulsory will go into effect January 1, 2022, in conjunction with the new FIG Code of Points.
- D. TOPS – It is not determined if TOPS will take place in 2020. If possible, State Testing will begin August 1, 2020, at the EARLIEST. Adjustments may need to be made to the TOPS National Testing and TOPS Camp dates. That will be determined at a later date as this is dependent on when stay-at-home orders are lifted nation-wide.
 - 1. NO changes to the TOPS Program skills or testing until January 1, 2022.
- E. It is not determined if training camps will occur in 2020. The IEC discussed a tentative plan for fall camps.
